Phase 1: Industrial Survey is not expected to incur project expenses; in the event project expenses are incurred, the costs will be shared evenly among participants. This Project Statement only covers the Phase 1 activities.
- Upon completion of the project’s Phase 1: Industrial Survey, the project participants will create a new SOW for Phase 2 including a listing of any project expenses expected to be incurred during Creep Corrosion Project’s Phase 2. The new Statement of Work and associated Project Statement will need approval of the iNEMI Technical Committee prior to being finalized.

<sup>3</sup> As provided for in the iNEMI Intellectual Property Policy, if background technology or intellectual property is claimed, a Declaration of same must be provided, in writing, to the iNEMI Secretariat within 45 days of signing this agreement.

<sup>4</sup> Intellectual property or background technology disclosed in a declaration can only be used by the project participants for the purpose of research in connection with this project, and not for commercial purposes.

- The iNEMI Creep Corrosion Project requires iNEMI membership. Results of the project will only be available if the iNEMI members who are project participants make them public. The project will acknowledge any non-members contribution or donations to the project by stating it in future project publications, presentations, and the final project report. In addition, non-member contributors' attendance and participation in the project's group meetings is limited to subjects concerning their contribution or donation, with an approval for attendance by a majority vote of iNEMI members who have signed this Project Statement.
- The project will adhere to the terms of the iNEMI Intellectual Property Policy for declaring, identifying, and disclosing background (confidential) technical information and background intellectual property.
- The data, information, and conclusions developed during this project will be available only to participating members of iNEMI who have formally joined this project by signing this Project Statement. All iNEMI members will be eligible to receive a summary report once it is released at the end of the project. The summary report will not contain data that the participants determine<sup>5</sup> should only be shared within the project.
- If iNEMI or one individual would like to present data or information gained in this project to another company or companies, in technical paper(s), or in article(s), every member of the project team must be informed and a simple majority is required for approval. The decision must be made during a regularly scheduled project meeting.
- Control of the data and information gathered during the execution of this project will transfer to the iNEMI Secretariat 12 months after the conclusion of the project. After that period all requests for publication or transmission of data collected must be reviewed and approved by iNEMI. If the project is extended to include additional phases, the Project Team will continue to provide approvals for communication outside the Project Team as outlined in the bullet above.
