Future Activity**2007 iNEMI Roadmap Technical Committee Review**

The next roadmap meeting will be in Kokomo, Indiana, at the Delphi Learning Center on August 9 and will be a face-to-face meeting of the TWG Chairs and the iNEMI Technical Committee. The purpose of the meeting will be to review the chapter drafts and discuss potential areas of improvement. This meeting has proven very valuable to the TWG Chapters and allows final updates prior to the September 22nd chapter submission deadline. All TWG Chairs should have received an email announcement in late June with the pertinent meeting, lodging and logistics details. If you haven't already submitted your chapter draft to Chuck, please send it as soon as possible to give the T.C. representative some time to review the chapter and put together their presentation.

Recent Activity

PEG Update. PEGs are working toward completing their chapter/emulator drafts for use by the TWGs in completing their chapters. The 2007 version of the Consumer/Portable, Aerospace/Defense, Automotive and Office/Large Business/Communications emulator spreadsheets have been distributed to TWG Chairs and the remaining Medical emulator is being finalized now. The first PEG Chapter submission was by the Automotive PEG on July 6th and was provided to the TWG Chairs on the same day.

TWG Update

The first iNEMI Roadmap Asian Workshop was held on June 27 in Shanghai China, in conjunction with the HDP '06 Conference. Approximately 25 individuals (most from Asian firms and Universities) participated in the half day workshop. Participants discussed the Consumer/Portable PEG chapter and five TWG chapters (Packaging; Board Assembly; Organic Interconnect Substrates; Environmentally Conscious Electronics; and Sensors). Feedback was

positive from the attendees and we look forward to increased levels of roadmap participation from Asian companies during future roadmap cycles. Presentations are available to TWG Chairs on the iNEMI FTP site. Please contact Chuck.Richardson@inemi.org for access information or individual copies.

TWG Chapter Status

As of July 13th, 3 of the 19 TWG chapter drafts have been received by the T.C. for review and preparation of their presentations for the meeting in Kokomo on August 9. The remaining 16 are expected before the end of July.
